August 23, 2023

Attendees: Cindy, Sharon, Donna, Troy, Mark, Luke, Marlyn, Carolyn

6:03 pm Troy calls the meeting to order. Mark leads the group in prayer.

Council minutes from the July meeting are read alone. Sharon motions to accept the minutes as presented. Carolyn seconds the motion. The motion passes.

Marlyn begins to discuss the Treasure's Report. Monthly Income was around \$9,300. Expenditures are higher, which is expected this time of year. We are also still operating under a deficit. Again, this was budgeted for and expected. Congregational giving this year compared to last year in the same time is up nearly \$3,000.00. We are still in great shape financially. Luke motions to accept the report as presented. Sharon seconds the motion. The motion passes.

Cindy starts by saying both Ford and Courtney and Karlie and Kolton have completed their pre-marriage sessions. As of today, August 23, the new electronic piano and baby changing stations have been purchased. Starting on September 10, our worship will be changing to the Narrative Lectionary This will lead to some readings we may not have covered in some years. We will begin with Genesis, Cindy would like to get with the Worship Team soon to begin planning services for our Advent Services. All confirmation classes have been completed. Confirmation Sunday will be October 29. This month she led worship at Kindred in Houston. Which is a dinner church typed worship with anyone who needs it. November 12<sup>th</sup> is the date for "Hymns and Beerfest". September 24<sup>th</sup> will be our New Member's Sunday.

Troy leads the discussion over our old business. He reiterates that on September 9<sup>th</sup> (God's Work, Our Hands weekend) we will meet at church to help cleaning around the church and parish hall and throwing away clutter. We will have a day for members to see if they would like to take anything home before it gets thrown out. We will meet in Greenvine at 8 am that Saturday. Troy plans on having an update to the bylaws by our Congregational Meeting to present for everyone. Mark is assisting with this.

New Agenda items include, Church committees or Ministry Teams as they will be called are being developed to help organize events such as Fellowship, Worship/Music, Outreach, Youth and Family, or Executive Council to name a few. We feel that this will be an improvement upon how committees are executed currently and ensure that the same people are not burdened with all the work year after year. Council members will serve as the liaison for each group to help build them and recruit members. Church members are encouraged to pick a committee that they think they'd enjoy and share their talents with to better Greenvine Emmanuel Lutheran Church. This will not be mandatory. More information on these will be coming in the next months.
